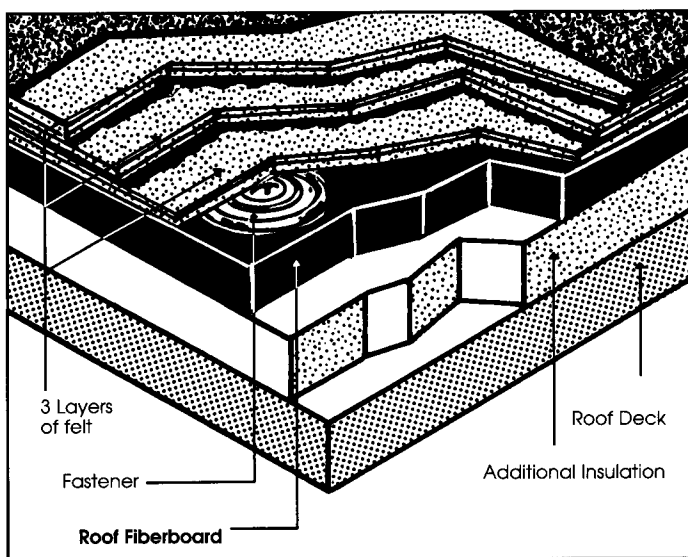


FIG A - Typical Built-Up Roof Application

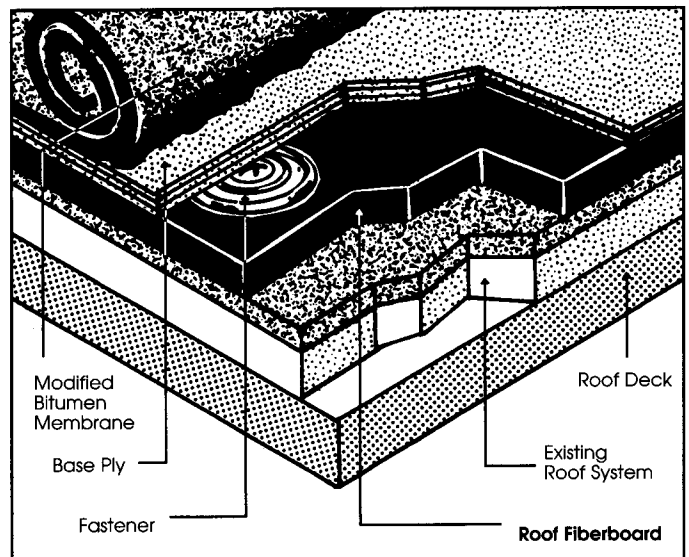


FIG B - Typical Modified Application

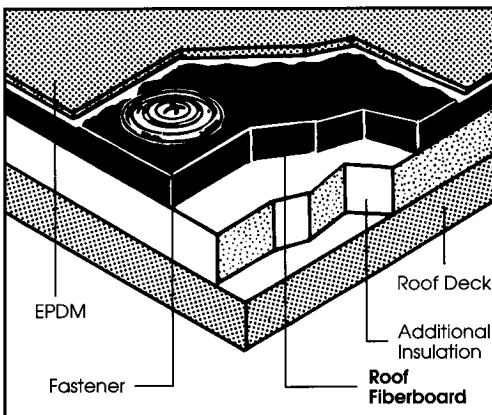


FIG C - Typical Membrane Application
